# Roof Restoration Project

Work on the roof continues but there is light at the end of the tunnel and the scaffolding should be down soon. Roof works are on time despite Lancaster council causing an initial 5 week delay and we are below our already revised lower budget which is great news.

However, there are some additional problems that have been uncovered with the render and pointing to the main stonework. Surveyors have confirmed that it is in a poor state and was just crumbling away potentially causing ingres of water and all the problems that would bring. This essential maintenance would need to be carried out within the next couple of years.

It seemed a sensible decision therefore to allow this work to be done now whilst the costly scaffolding is already in place.
